REPRESENTATIVE CODE OF CONDUCT**



The following rules comprise the “**Code of Conduct**”. All Albury Wodonga Football Association representative players must comply with these rules at all times; both on and off the field

**Players who fail to comply with these rules may;**

- Be returned to their parents/guardians, at the parents/guardians expense and, or
- Be excluded from further participation in the Albury Wodonga Football Association representative program and, or
- Be the subject of disciplinary action as determined by the Albury Wodonga Football Association executive committee

**Conduct outside these rules will not be tolerated;**

- All players selected for an Albury Wodonga Football Association representative team must make themselves available for all competitions in which that team participates.
- The use or possession of cigarettes, alcohol or any other substance classified as a drug of addiction and not prescribed by a medical practitioner is prohibited.
- Carry out all reasonable instructions as provided by the team coach, manager or Albury Wodonga Football Association executive member.
- Play by the rules.
- Never argue with an official. If you disagree, have your captain, coach or manager approach the official during or after the competition.
- Control your temper. Verbal abuse of officials and sledging other players, deliberately distracting or provoking an opponent are not acceptable or permitted behaviours in any sport
- Work equally hard for yourself and or your team. Your teams performance will benefit, so will you
- Be a good sport. Applaud all good plays whether they are made by your team or the opposition.
- Treat all participants in your sport as you like to be treated. Do not bully or take unfair advantage of another competitor.
- Cooperate with your coach, team mates and opponents. Without them there would be no competition.
- Participate for your own enjoyment and benefit, not just to please parents and coaches.
- Respect the rights, dignity and worth of all participants regardless of their gender, ability, cultural background or religion.
